All persons working in the construction Industry in Victoria are required to complete an industry-wide Occupational Health and Safety induction training course. Who should attend?

All persons who undertake onsite duties on a Victorian or national construction and building site.

Construction induction training

Construction induction training, aims to provide people new to construction work with an understanding of:

- their rights and responsibilities under OHS law
- common hazards and risks in the construction industry
- basic risk management principles, and
- the standard of behaviour expected of workers whilst on a construction site.

Issue of licence:

On successful completion of this course all participants will be issued their qualification to undertake work within the constructions and buildings industry from WorkSafe.

Proof of Identification

Any participant needs photo identification such as **ONE** of the following as proof of Identification:

- Passport – Australian – current or expired within the last two years – but not cancelled. International Passport **MUST BE CURRENT**.
- Drivers Licence – Australian with photo – **MUST BE CURRENT**.
- Drivers Learners Permit - Australian with photo – **MUST BE CURRENT**.
- Boat Operators Licence - Australian with photo – **MUST BE CURRENT**.
- Firearm Licence – Victorian with photo - **MUST BE CURRENT** (Can accept Interstate so long as it contains a photo and **MUST BE CURRENT**).
- State, Territory or Federal Government Employee ID Card with photo.
- Other Australian Government issued ID card with photo.
- Keypass ID Card with photo - **MUST BE CURRENT**.
- Consumer Affairs Victoria Proof of Age Card With Photo.
